


- Nutrien was formed in January 2018 as the result of a merger of equals between PotashCorp and Agrium.

Nutrien operates across the globe, with a complementary footprint of crop nutrient production and retail distribution assets in 14 countries.




Nutrien is a Global Leader in Crop Inputs




Market Capitalization

Manufacturing Capacity of Top Global Producers





Large and Diverse Production Asset Base




Total Combined Sales Volumes¹ (2017) Million Tonnes




